VII. Disclosure Statement

I understand that the financial aid application is not valid until I have signed this sheet, and my financial aid package will not be complete until I have completed my FAFSA and applied for admission at TTU. Intentional false statements or misrepresentation of any of the financial aid materials are punishable according to Federal law. If I determine corrections need to be made to any of the information I have previously submitted to apply for financial aid, I will contact the Tennessee Temple University Financial Aid Office for assistance.

I understand TTU reserves the right to modify my financial aid awards at any time due to changes in my financial aid eligibility or in the availability of funding. I am required to notify the Financial Aid Office of any changes in my financial status. (For example, if I receive any private scholarship or private loan not listed on my award letter.)

I understand that all scholarships are based on full-time enrollment (12 hours). If I am enrolled less than full-time, I will not qualify for scholarships and federal aid may be reduced. I also understand that if I live off-campus, my scholarship will be reduced by 50%. The refund policy is printed in the TTU catalog. Grades will be evaluated at the end of each semester and scholarships will be removed if the cumulative GPA is below the scholarship standards. Student must reapply for scholarships after the cumulative GPA is raised.. Institutional scholarships may only be stacked according to the scholarship guidelines available at www.tntemple.edu/financialaid.

I understand that NO cash refund will be given to me as a result of receiving any institutional scholarship in combination with another institutional scholarship, TTU work scholarship, Federal grant, or State grant. If an overage exists, institutional scholarships will be lowered in the amount of the overage. I understand all scholarships are listed in the amount of what I can receive. I may not receive the entire amount due to various reasons. Grants and scholarships will be credited to my Business Office account within two weeks after my financial aid file is complete and enrollment has been verified. Loan amounts will be posted when loan funds are received from the lender.

I understand that Federal Work Study (FWS) and TTU work scholarship amounts are estimates only. FWS and TTU work scholarship students will receive payment via credits to their Business Office accounts according to the hours worked.

I understand financial aid is not automatically renewable; I must reapply each academic year by filling out a new FAFSA and a returning student financial aid application. To continue receiving aid, I must maintain satisfactory academic progress (SAP) as defined in the University catalog, and must be enrolled in a degree program.
