



Grants

*These funds are offered by the Department of Education or other organizations to those that qualify and are not required to be paid back.

Pell Grant- offered by the Federal government to undergraduate students with a qualifying EFC. Amount determined by EFC and enrollment, up to \$5350.

SEOG (Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant)-Offered by the Federal government to Pell recipients with remaining financial need after scholarships and Pell.

ACG (Academic Competitiveness Grant)- Offered by the Federal government to Pell recipients, enrolled full time or part time as freshmen or sophomores. Student must have completed a rigorous secondary school program of study. Potential eligibility is indicated on the FAFSA or a student can self-certify (provide documentation of a rigorous secondary school program). \$750 first year, \$1,300 second year.

SMART (Science and Mathematics Access to Retain Talent) - Offered by the Federal government to Pell recipients, enrolled full time as juniors or seniors. Must be majoring in physical science, life science, computer science, engineering, mathematics, technology, or a critical foreign language. Must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA. \$4,000 each for third and fourth years.

TSAC- Offered by the **Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation** to student's with an EFC of 2,100 or less. Funds are limited and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. TSAC will notify you if you qualify for this grant.
